## THORL September meeting.

THORL's first meeting after the summer of 2019 is on 29<sup>th</sup> September.

The HO track will be placed atop Pinewoods 1/24 track.

The race format for the day will be slightly different to that of previous THORL events.

The venue will be open from 9am. There will be no running on the track at this time unless specified by race control for track functionality checks.

At 10am practice will start (please be at the venue by 9:45 latest for sign on).

The race control system will display the drivers for the current and next practice heat.

Practice heats are planned to be 3 minutes long with a 1 minute changeover.

All drivers will be entered for practice on all lanes. The race control system will be automatic, and it is the drivers responsibility to check if they are on track.

Only the named driver may use the designated lane, and only for the class running that morning. For Autumn Awesome, Mega G/+ Chassis'ed cars with closed wheel bodies.

During practice, all marshal positions are to be manned.

After practice, heats and finals will start. Full class rules can be found on the THORL website.

'Afternoon' racing will consist of Wizzard handout cars, using a segmented format.

Drivers will be rotated between each heat, rather than the previous format of all heats on one go.

If time allows, more than one handout class may be run.
